Head markings were solid black cap, white band below ~~to~~ to eye, bold black patch thru eye and extending slightly below, white below onto neck. Underparts whites, sides lightly streaked with black. Back and tail dark gray. Wings with two wing bars. Warbler-shaped dark beak.
