- 8. **LIGHT CONDITIONS (RELATIVE TO OBSERVER)**: excellent. Very nearly behind me as I looked at the bird
- 9. OPTICAL EQUIPMENT: 10x42 binoculars, 60X on Kowa scope
- 10. **DISTANCE TO BIRD**: ranged from 30 to 75 yards
- 11: **DURATION OF OBSERVATION:** about 2 minutes
- 12. HABITAT: shrubby vegetation and power line
- 13: NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF OBSERVATION; BEHAVIOR: When I first saw it, it was perched on top of a bush (baccharis?). As I moved the car closer, it flew up to a power or telphone line. I looked at it there, then carefully tried to get out of the car to get a photograph, and it flew further down the wire. I got out and scoped it at 60X, then tried to move up on it again for a photo, and it flew down the r idge out of sight. Light was excellent, the air quite steady, so 60X were easily used.
- 14. **DESCRIPTION OF BIRD**: kingbird, resembling an Eastern Kingbird, but much grayer, with a very heavy, long bill, very clear black face mask, and no white tip to tail.

- 16. **SIMILAR SPECIES AND HOW ELIMINATED**: see above re EAKI: heavy bill, blackish mask, grayer plumage, no white tip to tail. Fantasy: Thick-billed Kingbird: would be hard to rule out definitively, except not noticeably robust, no brownish edgings noted, bill almost certainly too small.
- 17. **RESOURCES USED IN IDENTIFICATION (FIELD GUIDES, ETC.):** after the bird flew, I checked Thick-billed just in case using Sibley.
