We hope it can be released but it is too early to tell. I have attached some pictures. Also, we have various Bald Eagle carcasses that I am trying to figure out if USFW still wants them or not. Would you be interested in any of them for the museum? Most will have some fracture or obvious injury. If you want to come see the Golden Eagle let me know. He/she is very flighty so we can't have a parade of people but we'll be glad to have a few people from the museum come by if interested. We also have a Bald Eagle with a wing fracture.
