Circumstances Stakeout since Dec. 5, 2023, with intermittent appearances for several weeks. Banded and marked by NLN. Appeared around dawn, as predicted by Diana, and landed in crape myrtle between visits to feeders on several occasions during observation over 90 minutes or so. After visits to feeders, it usually flew to back of yard where PEC located it perching in several spots in back bottlebrush hedge-scope views. 55, ene 5-10, cloudy, light rain at end.

Details: A very large hummingbird with long, thick, decurved black bill, green back with white breast bisected by green feathers from chin to belly; rufous tail base, white tips.
