11. Distance to bird(s): appx 60 yards.
12. Duration of observation: about 15 minutes
13. Habitat: parking lot near landfill; much rocky material and concrete.
14. Behavior of bird/circumstances of observation (flying, feeding, resting; include and stress habits used in identification; relate events surrounding observation): Primarily at rest, and seemingly in close company with a Ring-billed Gull; generally in vicinity of other gulls of mixed species hanging around this parking area. Upon attempting to draw attention by throwing bread, other species (particularly Laughing Gulls) were drawn in, but was ignored by the Iceland Gull. At some point later while observing, the Iceland Gull took off and went to another area where we were unable to relocate it.

Description (include only what was actually seen, <i>not what "should" have been seen;</i> include if possible: total length/relative size compared to other familiar species, body bulk, shape, proportions, bill, eye, leg, and plumage characteristics. Stress features that separate it from similar species): All-white gull, about the same size as or slightly larger than a Ring-billed Gull (one of which was next to the Iceland). No gray or black in the plumage, so the black bill with pink/flesh-colored base and dark eye were evident against the all-white head. The legs were pink/flesh-colored.
16. Voice: Silent (no vocalization heard).
17. Similar species (include how they were eliminated by your observation): Ivory Gull and Glaucous Gull both eliminated based on the size of the bird.
