

Hi Paul,

I initially located the bird towards the back of the Grilletta Tract just past the stand of bamboo about 4:50 pm on April 8. It was roosting at about 12ft high and allowed a fairly close approach (~20ft) without flushing. I went back the next morning and located it in the same tree at about 7:25 am. Similar to the day before it allowed close approach and did not flush.

I only see ebird reports from myself and the two others you copied on this email, but there were a good number of birders who saw it so other photos may exist somewhere. Many were calling it a Chuck at the time.
