- 9. Light: okay we were looking north at the perched bird, and it flew generally east
- 10. Optics: 10x42 Eagle, excellent condition
- 11. Distance originally maybe 60-70 yds; subsequently much closer, especially for some of the others who were ahead of me walking to the bird
- 12. Duration: a couple of minutes
- 13. Habitat: sitting on a power line within the main group of camps in town
- 14. Behavior: sitting on power line: flew off fairly low to ground
- 15. Description: clearly a nighthawk. Perched it seemed quite buffy below. In flight the buffiness below was confirmed. More significantly it had rather blunt tipped wings, the wing patches were out near the tips, and the wing patches on both upper and lower surfaces were buffy, not white.
- 16. voice: not heard
- 17. Similar species: Common Nighthawk is the main problem, but I guess Antillean would be a remote possibility. the wing shape and location of the wing patches seemed better to me than for Common or Antillean. Also, I'm not sure if they are diagnostic, but the buffy color of the wing patches is better for Lesser.
- 18. Photographs: Dan Purrington got at least one pretty good one which he scanned and sent to various people; I don't know if he submitted it to the committee. If he has not, then I will urge him to do so.
- 19. Previous experience: a few Lessers in LA, many out west. Many Commons.
- 20. Aids: don't recall, maybe Geo or Sibley at the time. Later I checked various guides.
- 21. Description made from notes scribbled in the field
- 22. Based on what I saw of the bird, I could not be 100% sure, unless the buffy color of the wing patches eliminates Common.
